Discretionary Grant Application

Grant applications can be received from registered Iwi members living in NZ who can whakapapa to Ngāti Rongomai Iwi.

Please make sure you have read the Ngāti Rongomai Iwi Trust Grant Policy document.

Applicants must also demonstrate that their application is consistent with the strategic vision of the Ngāti Rongomai Iwi Trust (NRIT)

A **Discretionary Grant** may be considered to support whānau in an activity that is consistent with the strategic vision of the Ngāti Rongomai Iwi Trust (NRIT) but falls outside the other grant categories.

Important information:

1. Funding can only be used for the purpose outlined in the application
2. Funding will not be provided for projects or study that are retrospective (i.e. where a project or study has already commenced or is virtually completed before the funding round closes)
3. The maximum grant amount available in any financial year period will be decided by Ngāti Rongomai Iwi Trust Board in relation to available funding in any one year
4. Only one grant is available per individual in any financial year period
5. Once NRIT grant funding has been exhausted in any one year no more applications will be considered in that financial year
6. A valid email address and contact phone number must be provided
7. Include a Bank Deposit slip or statement (verifying your account number entered online)
8. Any unused funds must be returned to Ngāti Rongomai Iwi Trust
9. Applicants are required to provide an accountability report one month after the completion of their projects or as agreed in writing and to attend NRIT AGM to present a report on their project.
